2019 Christ Episcopal Church Education Scholarship Eligibility Requirements, Terms, and Instructions

Christ Episcopal Church Education Scholarship has annually been assisting Charlevoix area high school graduating seniors to participate with post-secondary education. This scholarship opportunity was introduced to the local high school community in 2011 by Christ Episcopal Church Interim Minister, Reverend John David and church Vestry member, Ann Hollis.

Members of Christ Episcopal Church embraced the scholarship program and have helped provide annual awards to nearly two dozen students. During 2015 Christ Episcopal Church hosted a fundraising event to increase awareness about the importance of committing financial assistance to local area graduating seniors who are pursuing continuing education.

This year, Christ Episcopal Church will award up to three (3) \$1,000.00 scholarships.

Please take the time to read the instructions outlined below completely and thoroughly before filling out your application.

All applications must be received or postmarked by March 21, 2019.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Graduating seniors must attend high school full-time in Charlevoix County.
2. Applicants must be in good academic standing.
3. Applicants must submit a fully completed application postmarked by the deadline.
4. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited college, university, or technical school (not limited to the state of Michigan) in the fall of 2019.

Terms of Scholarship

1. Up to three (3) \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded.
2. The scholarship may be used for any school related expense.
3. Scholarship recipients are notified by telephone, and/or email.

Application Instructions

1. Please PRINT neatly or type.
2. You must complete the entire **scholarship application form**. If information is not applicable, please identify as N/A.
3. Enclose the following:
 - a. A completed **application form**
 - b. A copy of your academic **transcript**
 - c. Your **standardized test scores**
 - d. At least **one (1) letter of recommendation** or reference (from teacher, employer, community leader, or school official). Additional letters may be submitted
 - e. An **essay**, with a maximum of 500 words, explaining, your career goals and how higher education will assist you in achieving these goals.
 - f. A copy of a **letter of acceptance** from the school you plan to attend in the fall (or acceptance letters from schools you are considering)
 - g. A **copy of your Free Application Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) score, including the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).**

Award Process

The Christ Episcopal Church Education Scholarship Ministry will review all complete applications received by the deadline. Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of financial need, scholastic achievement, the essay as well as involvement in school and community activities. All information included in the application will be held in strictest confidence.

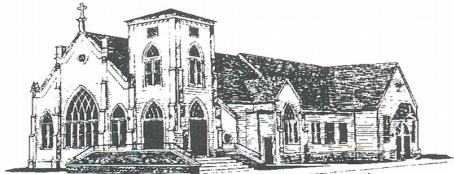
